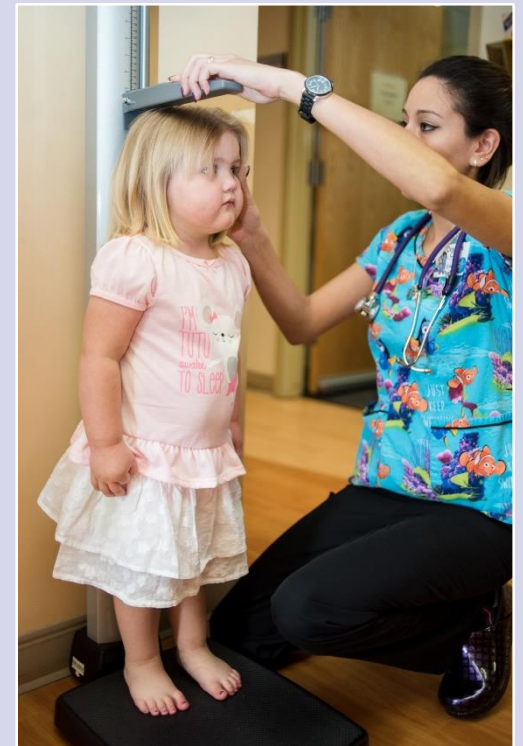

- **Doctors Care Clinic** - providing quality health care
- **Doctors Care Advantage** - community-based health access program
- **Connection to Coverage** - Medicaid/insurance options
- **Health Navigation** - finding solutions to better health



4 CORE SERVICES IMPACT - 2018

Clinic

- 2,600 patients
- 7,300 clinic visits
- 500 behavioral health visits
- 900 dental hygiene visits



Connect to Coverage

- 1,300 total enrollments
- 988 enrolled in Medicaid
- 551 enrolled in Qualified Health Plans



4 CORE SERVICES IMPACT - 2018

Health Navigation

- 2,452 psychosocial screens
- 1,733 positive screens
- Over 2,000 resources for food, vision, prescription and housing assistance.



Doctors Care Advantage

- 72 individuals enrolled in Premium Sponsorship Program that helps low-income individuals and families afford insurance on the Connect for Health Colorado online marketplace.

VOLUNTEER ENGAGEMENT

- DC engages volunteers in clinical and nonclinical areas of the organization.
- Physicians and other medical providers provided \$401,000 in services last year, allowing us to leverage that time and expertise to serve more patients.
- Doctors Care received 2,000 additional non medical hours of service for programming and administration i.e. Health Coverage Guides, Health Navigators, Front Desk Greeters, etc.



DC PAYMENT MODEL

- Medicaid reimburses at 50% of actual clinic costs.
- No reimbursement mechanism for social support services.
- Volunteer engagement helps offset costs.
- Fundraising from individuals, foundations, government, community and faith-based organizations necessary to meet costs of delivering services.
