Arapahoe County notice of public hearings and meetings

2015 Action plan for Community Development Block Grants and HOME Investment Partnership Act Funds

Littleton, Colo. – Citizens, public agencies and other interested parties are invited to attend a presentation and provide input on how the County should prioritize federal funding for housing and community development in 2015.

Public hearings will be held for the following communities: Centennial, Deer Trail, Englewood, Glendale, Greenwood Village, Littleton, Sheridan and unincorporated Arapahoe County.

The County encourages citizen participation, emphasizing the involvement of moderate, low, and extremely low income residents in areas where funds may be spent. The CDBG program is a U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development entitlement program, which allocates annual grants to Arapahoe County to develop viable communities by providing decent affordable housing, a suitable living environment and expanded economic opportunities, mainly for low and moderate income residents.

The annual grant amount received by the County is determined by HUD and is based on population size and the number of applicable residents.

Public comment will be accepted following the presentation and will be added to the County's 2015 Action Plan. Written comments will also be accepted Jan. 30 to March 2.

Public hearings will be held at 2 p.m., Jan. 27 and 9:30 a.m., March 3 at the Arapahoe County Administration Building, West Hearing Room, 5334 S. Prince Street, Littleton.

The first public meeting will be held noon, Jan. 28 at the Centennial Civic Center, Aspen Room, 13133 E. Arapahoe Road, Centennial.

The second public meeting will be held 6 p.m., Jan. 28 at the Arapahoe County Administration Building, West Hearing Room.

The proposed action plan will be available to the public upon request and online starting Jan.
