Arapahoe County Clerk and Recorder extends passport hours

Applications for passports now accepted weekdays 7 a.m. – 5 p.m. at Littleton Branch

LITTLETON, CO – Metro-area residents may have lost one hour of sleep due to Daylight Savings, but they can now take advantage of an extra hour on weekdays to apply for a U.S. passport at the Arapahoe County Clerk and Recorder's Littleton Branch.

Clerk and Recorder Matt Crane extended the hours for passport services to 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday-Friday. Applications were previously accepted until 4 p.m. These extended hours will help to meet rising demand for passports, enhance customer service and coincide with office hours for Motor Vehicle, Elections and Recording services at the Littleton Branch office. Arapahoe County processed 5,725 passport applications last year, an increase of 27 percent over 2013.

The Clerk and Recorder's Office accepts passport applications on behalf of the U.S. Department of State at its Recording Office in the County Administration Building, 5334 S. Prince St., Littleton. No appointment is necessary. All applicants, including minors, must apply in-person.

Each applicant must bring an unsigned, completed [passport application](#); one color passport photo measuring two by two inches; proof of citizenship; photo identification; and two (2) checks or money orders to cover the \$25 County processing fee and a federal application fee. Passports will arrive by mail within four to six weeks, or can be expedited at an additional cost.

Arapahoe County does not accept passports renewals. Please find passport application and renewal forms, fees and information at www.travel.state.gov/passport.
