Kathleen Hammer, Planner, stated that the applicant is requesting an extension, which staff supports. She provided the history of the previous extension and explained the request for the extension.

Ms. Hammer clarified that staff is recommending a 12-month extension; a 2-month extension could be an alternative.

Cynthia Myers, representing Century Communities, explained the purpose of the request for the 12-month extension.

The following motion was made by Commissioner Jackson, duly seconded by Commissioner Baker: In the case of GDP18-005, Towns @ South of Cherry Creek General Development Plan, the County Commissioners have reviewed the staff report, including all exhibits and attachments, and have listened to the applicant's presentation.
