5.a. Resolution No. 200578 - Extension of the Billboard Moratorium

Robert Hill, Senior Assistant County Attorney, established jurisdiction for the Board to consider this matter.

Kathleen Hammer, Planner II, explained the request to extend the temporary moratorium.

The public comment period was opened.

There were no public comments.

The public comment period was closed.

The following motion was made by Commissioner Jackson duly seconded by Commissioner Holen: In the matter of the fourth request to extend a temporary moratorium on the acceptance and processing of applications for any new billboard or other off-premise sign and on applications for conversion of any existing billboard or other off-premise sign to an electronic messaging sign, as was adopted pursuant to Resolution No. 190273, I have considered the Planning staff recommendation, reviewed the Board Summary Report, and heard such public testimony and staff comment as was presented to the Board at public hearing this day. I move that the Board of County Commissioners adopt by resolution a fourth extension to the temporary moratorium on the acceptance and processing of applications for such billboards or other off-premise signs and conversion of any existing billboard or off-premise sign to an electronic messaging sign as presented to the Board. Such moratorium shall be extended for an additional four months to January 7, 2021.

The motion passed 5-0.
