Arapahoe County to close three buildings, all Motor Vehicle and Recording offices on Nov. 4 Election Day

Closing buildings will free up parking and staff to assist with General Election

LITTLETON, CO – Three Arapahoe County campuses and all motor vehicle and recording services will be closed on Nov. 4 Election Day in order to free up parking for citizens at Voter Service and Polling Center locations, and enable Clerk and Recorder employees to assist with the election.

The Board of County Commissioners approved closing the County Administration Building, CentrePoint Plaza and Lima Plaza Nov. 4 at the request of Clerk and Recorder Matt Crane.

In addition, the Clerk and Recorder's branches will be closed except for election services or ballot drop-off. No driver's license, motor vehicle title or registration, or recording services will be offered in Arapahoe County on Election Day. Citizens may visit www.arapahoegov.com to renew their driver's license or motor vehicle registration online.

County employees will report to work as scheduled and may be called upon to help with election tasks if necessary, such as directing citizens, answering phones and processing mail-in ballots.

The building closures will include:

- **The County Administration Building** at 5334 S. Prince St., Littleton, including the Assessor, Treasurer and Commissioners' Offices, and the Clerk and Recorder's Motor Vehicle and Recording Divisions. In addition, the Board of County Commissioners canceled their Nov. 4 study sessions. The lobby will be open as a Voter Service and Polling Center.
- **CentrePoint Plaza** at 14980 E. Alameda Dr., Aurora, including Human Services. The main level will be open as a Voter Service and Polling Center.
- **The Lima Plaza campus** on Lima Street in Centennial, which includes the Arapahoe/Douglas Works! Workforce Center, Public Works and Development, Open Spaces and Judicial Services. The Clerk and Recorder Branch at 6954 S. Lima Street will be open for election-related services only as a Voter Service and Polling Center.
- **The Motor Vehicle Office in Byers** will be open for election-related services only as a Voter Service and Polling Center.
- The **Altura Plaza Driver's License Office in Aurora** and the **Aurora Motor Vehicle Branch Office** will be open for ballot drop-off only.

All other County buildings will be open to the public as normal Nov. 4, including the Sheriff's Administration and Coroner's Facility in Centennial, the Human Services satellite office at Arapahoe Plaza in Littleton, and the Arapahoe/Douglas Works! satellite office at Altura Plaza in Aurora.

Because Clerk and Recorder's Office employees will be working late through the night to process ballots, the County's Motor Vehicle, Driver's License and Recording offices will reopen to the public at 10 a.m., Wednesday, Nov. 5. All other buildings will re-open at 8 a.m., Nov. 5.

All active registered voters will receive mail ballots for the 2014 General Election. Citizens may visit any one of 25 [Voter Service and Polling Centers](#) to drop off their voted mail ballot, register to vote in-person through Election Day, request or replace a ballot, or vote on an accessible voting machine. All Voter Service and Polling Center locations will be open 7 a.m. - 7 p.m. on Election Day.
