INTRODUCED BY COUNCILMEMBER BULLOCK

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING CITY COUNCIL'S DECLARATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY TO ALLOW REMOTE PARTICIPATION IN MEETINGS, CONTINUE SUSPENSION OF ENFORCEMENT OF TEMPORARY SIGN CODE PROVISIONS, AND CONTINUE TO ACCOMMODATE OUTDOOR EATING AREAS

WHEREAS, City Council declared by Resolution No. 19, Series of 2020, a local disaster emergency through May 5, 2020, suspending regular procedures for conducting public meetings of City Council and all Boards and Commissions, and activating the response and recovery aspects of any and all applicable local and interjurisdictional disaster emergency plans and to seek and authorize the furnishing of aid and assistance under such plans; and

WHEREAS, City Council declared by Resolution No. 20, Series of 2020, that enforcement of portions of the Sign Code relating to temporary signage should be suspended in order to allow businesses to communicate the availability of services during and after the COVID-19 emergency; and

WHEREAS, City Council adopted Resolution No. 22, Series of 2020 on May 4, 2020, extending the Declaration of Emergency to June 30 in order to extend the suspension of sign code provisions through the end of June and to continue remote meetings through June 1; and

WHEREAS, City Council adopted Resolution No. 25, Series of 2020 on May 18, 2020, waiving license and permit fees and restrictions on outdoor eating areas through September 8, 2020; and

WHEREAS, City Council adopted Resolution No. 27, Series of 2020 on June 1, 2020, continuing the declaration of emergency and continuing remote meeting participation, the suspension of sign code provisions, and waiving license and permit fees pertaining to outdoor dining areas through September 15, 2020; and

WHEREAS, City Council adopted Resolution No. 46, Series of 2020 on September 14, 2020, extending the declaration of emergency and continuing remote meeting participation, the suspension of sign code provisions, and waiving license and permit fees pertaining to outdoor dining areas through December 31, 2020; and

WHEREAS, City Council adopted Resolution No. 59, Series of 2020 on November 16, 2020, extending the declaration of emergency and continuing remote meeting participation, the suspension of sign code provision, and waiving license and permit fees regarding outdoor dining through March 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, City Council desires to extend the local state of emergency until June 30, 2021 in order to allow continued remote participation by City Council and Boards and Commissions members through the month of June, and to continue the suspension of the

enforcement of temporary sign code provisions and waiver of license and permit fees pertaining to outdoor eating areas in order to continue to assist local businesses through that time.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENWOOD VILLAGE:

1. The State of Emergency last extended by Resolution No. 59, Series 2020 is hereby extended to June 30, 2021. Regular procedures for conducting public meetings of City Council and all Boards and Commissions may resume, but individual members of City Council and Boards and Commissions may continue to participate remotely during the State of Emergency.
2. Suspension of Sign Code provisions relating to temporary signage addressed in Resolution No. 20, Series of 2020, continue to be suspended until June 30, 2021.
3. Provisions of the Greenwood Village Municipal Code pertaining to permit fees for the use of tents, Outdoor Eating areas, and Greenwood Village Beer and Liquor Regulations pertaining to Modification of Licensed Premises addressed by Resolution No. 25, Series of 2020, continue through June 30, 2021.
4. A copy of this Declaration shall be filed immediately with the City Clerk, the Arapahoe County Clerk and Recorder, and the Colorado Office of Emergency Management.
