**RESOLUTION
OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF
EAST CHERRY CREEK VALLEY WATER & SANITATION DISTRICT**

TERMINATION OF DECLARATION OF LOCAL DISASTER EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Colorado declared a statewide emergency regarding the occurrence and imminent threat of widespread or severe damage, injury or loss of life or property resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic (“Statewide Emergency Declaration”); and

WHEREAS, the East Cherry Creek Valley Water and Sanitation District (the “District”) determined that it was in the public interest to have emergency resources available to work to safeguard the health and safety of the community during the Statewide Emergency Declaration; and

WHEREAS, on April 2, 2020, the District Manager declared a local disaster emergency for the District as a result of the imminent threat caused by the COVID-19 pandemic pursuant to Section 24-33.5-709, C.R.S. (the “Declaration of Local Disaster Emergency”); and

WHEREAS, the effect of the Declaration of Local Disaster Emergency was to activate the response and recovery aspects of any and all applicable local and interjurisdictional disaster emergency plans and to authorize the furnishing of aid and assistance under such plans; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 24-33.5-709, C.R.S., the Board of Directors of the District (the “Board”) determined to extend the Declaration of Local Disaster Emergency in that certain Resolution No. 2020-006 Continuation of Declaration of Local Disaster Emergency, dated April 9, 2020 (the “Continuation of Local Disaster Emergency”), until such time as the Board determined; and

WHEREAS, on July 8, 2021, the Governor of the State of Colorado rescinded the Statewide Emergency Declaration as most of the measures directed toward responding to the COVID-19 pandemic emergency are no longer needed; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to terminate the Declaration of Local Disaster Emergency as the imminent threat caused by the COVID-19 pandemic has subsided and in response to the rescission of the Statewide Emergency Declaration.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE EAST CHERRY CREEK VALLEY WATER AND SANITATION DISTRICT RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:



CONTINUATION DECLARATION OF LOCAL DISASTER EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Colorado has declared a statewide emergency regarding the occurrence or imminent threat of widespread or severe damage, injury or loss of life or property resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest for the East Cherry Creek Valley Water and Sanitation District (the "District") to have emergency resources available to work to safeguard the health and safety of the community; and

WHEREAS, on April 2, 2020, the District Manager declared a local disaster emergency for the District as a result of the imminent threat caused by the COVID-19 pandemic pursuant to Section 24-33.5-709, C.R.S. (the "Declaration of Local Disaster Emergency"); and

WHEREAS, the effect of the Declaration of Local Disaster Emergency is to activate the response and recovery aspects of any and all applicable local and inter-jurisdictional disaster emergency plans and to authorize the furnishing of aid and assistance under such plans; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 24-33.5-709, C.R.S., the Declaration of Local Disaster Emergency shall not be continued or renewed for a period in excess of seven days except by or with the consent of the Board of Directors of the District (the "Board"); and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to continue the Declaration of Local Disaster Emergency until such time as the imminent threat caused by the COVID-19 pandemic has subsided.


NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE EAST CHERRY CREEK VALLEY WATER AND SANITATION DISTRICT RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Declaration of Local Disaster Emergency, attached hereto as Exhibit A, is hereby continued until such time as the Board determines, due to the imminent threat caused by the COVID-19 pandemic.
2. The District Manager is directed to continue implementing measures with respect to District employees and access to certain District owned facilities. This continuation shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed with the Arapahoe County Clerk and Recorder and with the Colorado Office of Emergency Management.

DECLARATION OF LOCAL DISASTER EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Colorado has declared a statewide emergency regarding the occurrence or imminent threat of widespread or severe damage, injury or loss of life or property resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest for the East Cherry Creek Valley Water and Sanitation District (the "District") to have emergency resources available to work to safeguard the health and safety of the community; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 24-33.5-709, C.R.S. the District Manager is authorized to declare a local disaster emergency; and

WHEREAS, the effect of the declaration of a local disaster emergency is to activate the response and recovery aspects of any and all applicable local and interjurisdictional disaster emergency plans and to authorize the furnishing of aid and assistance under such plans.


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

Section 1. The District Manager hereby declares a local disaster emergency for the District, pursuant to Section 24-33.5-709, C.R.S.. due to the imminent threat caused by the COVID-19 pandemic. The District Manager is implementing measures with respect to District employees and access to certain District owned facilities.

Section 2. This Declaration shall be effective until April 9, 2020, unless continued by the Board of Directors of the District. This declaration shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed with the Arapahoe County Clerk and Recorder and with the Colorado Office of Emergency Management.
